This week, the *TATTLE R* concludes its series of reprinted articles and reports found *Billboard Radio Monitor & All Access*, with a final *Monitor* article reflecting upon what was learned at the 31st annual Learning Conference. Our thanks to *Billboard's* Paul Heine and All Access' Joel Denver and their respective staffs for their detailed coverage of the conference, covered here over the past few weeks: **Promotion Summit Kicks Off 31st Annual Conclave (Ken Tucker)**. Promotions directors, marketing directors and programmers from across the country have gathered here for the Promotions Summit, which kicked off the 31st annual Conclave learning conference. The second annual summit included four sessions; the first two key sessions tackled the topics of sales and added value. *"Sales and Promotions — A Happy Marriage Is Possible."* **Clear Channel KEEY (K102)** Minneapolis general sales manager **Rob Berrell** and other panelists were adamant that communication and flexibility are key to successful promotions. "Almost every idea can be morphed into something that will work," **Greater Media WCSX** Detroit new media marketing director **Jennifer Williams** said. "You have to think things through and figure out what's right for the client and the station." "I try to make it a goal to not say 'no,' but sometimes I have to say 'no, but,'" **Clear Channel KQBW (the Brew)** Omaha, Neb., PD **Michelle Matthews** added. *"Turning Lemons Into Lemonade — Turning Added Value Into Real Money"* featured **Pop2Life** president **Eric Murphy**, **Pinnacle Media Worldwide** VP International **Ken Benson**, **Clear Channel/New York** senior sales director **Andrea Duggan** and **Marquee Concerts** founder **Sam Kimball**. Advertisers want to tap into radio's relationship with its listeners, the panelists agreed. The Internet, events and concerts, product placement, experiential marketing, text messaging and mobile marketing, content on demand, podcasting, blogs and social networking are all opportunities for radio in the next five years. A 5 share station has the opportunity to bring in more ad dollars than an 8 share station, according to Murphy, if they are more creative with their NTR opportunities. Meanwhile, Benson encouraged programmers to be involved the sales and marketing process. "Nobody knows the audience better than you," he said. The panel agreed that it's important that new opportunities carry a price tag and not be added value. "Once you give it away, they're never going to pay for it," Duggan said.

Clear Channel Radio continues to restructure its management team, with an announcement this morning that it will be reducing management layers in a "flatter, more nimble" fashion by retaining current VP's while – according to a Clear Channel memo - "the job descriptions and responsibilities associated with them are quite different." In the Midwest, **Dave Crowl** retains his SVP title (one of 4 SVP's...down from 7 prior to the reorganization...while the region receives not one-not two-but THREE SVP's of programming (for a total of 4 SVPs, down from 6): **Michael Martin** (Western & Central), **Gene Romano** (Eastern & Central), and **Alan Sledge** (Western & Central). **Marc Chase** will be handling the Eastern region's programming with Romano. The region will be commandeered by these President/Market Managers: **Earl Jones/Chicago**, **Mike Kenney/Cleveland**, **Til Levesque/Detroit**, and **Mick Anselmo/Minneapolis**. In addition, the company named/renamed the following as Regional VPs (managing specific markets and also overseeing other geographies): **Morgan Bohannon**, **Linda Byrd**, **Michael Crusham**, **Bruce Demps**, **Dan DiLoreto**, **Alene Grevey**, **Michele Grosenick**, **Jeff Holden**, **Lee Larsen**, **Dick Lewis**, **Matt Martin** and **Tom McConnell**.

FCC Commissioner **Jonathan Adelstein**, 2005 Conclave Keynote and the only Commissioner to dissent in part from the indecency rulings earlier this year, told the Progress And Freedom Foundation in Aspen earlier this week that his Commission's rulings "dangerously expands the scope of indecency and profanity law without first attempting to determine whether we are applying the appropriate contemporary community standards." In his speech, he reiterated agreement with the rest of the Commission that "the government has a legitimate interest in protecting children from indecent and overly commercial content." But he warned that the Omnibus order does not provide broadcasters with a "coherent and principled framework." And that, he predicted, could jeopardize the ability of the FCC to do any regulation of indecency. Said the Commissioner from South Dakota, "We may forever lose the ability to prevent the airing of indecent material, barring an unlikely constitutional amendment setting limits on the First Amendment". He also received praise from the group for his opposition to government mandated multicast must-carry and cable a la carte. "Because I have been such an outspoken opponent of media consolidation- for which I make no apology - it may not always be clear that I believe restraint is often warranted."

On 8/18, **CBS Talk WCKG/Chicago** featured a reunion between **Steven Dahl** and **Garry Meier**, old radio partners who famously split in 1993 and who seem to have reconciled amicably. Partners since 1979, the relationship dissolved over remarks Dahl made about Meier and his wife. In recent years, Meier has partnered with **Roe Conn**. Catch the historic burying-of-the-hatchet on a repeat airing: the Dahl "Back to the Beach" remote will air one more time at the 2-7 pm slot, on Friday, 8/25 (also streaming on www.1059freem.com).



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Eleanor Mondale, daughter of former Vice President **Walter Mondale**, is taking a job at **CBS Talk WCCO-AM/Minneapolis** as co-host, with **Susie Jones**, of the midday 9am-Noon (Central Time) slot. This represents a triumph for Mondale, as last year, following a diagnosis of two brain tumors, she was told she had six months to live. Treatment, including chemotherapy and radiation at the Mayo Clinic, has caused the tumors to disappear or shrink to “non-threatening” status. Mondale is a former host at E! Entertainment Television and CBS.

Peyton Manning, Indianapolis Colts Quarterback, accompanied by his father, **former Viking Archie Manning**, made a visit to the **Clear Channel** Rocker WFBQ/Indianapolis studios on Monday, to raise money for Manning's Payback Foundation, a organization that assists programs in providing leadership and growth opportunities for disadvantaged youths. Together with **Premier Radio Networks** cut-ups **Bob and Tom**, Manning oversaw an on-air auction, which included three sets of autographed helmets from Peyton, Archie and Eli Manning. The auction raised \$44,500 in about four hours.

Legendary sportscaster **Bob Costas** is going to helm a weekend syndicated talk show, under the auspices of **Premiere Radio Networks** and **Clear Channel Radio**. The show, entitled “Costas on the Radio,” is premiering September 16th and will air on at least 75 stations. Starting on October 9th, it will feature “The Costas Cuts” and “The Costas Minute,” two 60-second vignettes. The show will also air on non-sports outlets. Costas has previously had a weekend syndicated radio show “Costas Coast-to-Coast” and a late night TV show “Later...With Bob Costas.” He was the keynote speaker of the 1990 Conclave Learning Conference and he is currently host for NBC's NFL coverage.

Former KDWB/Minneapolis talent **J. J. Kincaid** had been tapped to be the new afternoon star of **Clear Channel** Top 40 WHTZ (Z100)/New York. He currently works afternoons at sister Top 40 KHKS(106.1/KISS-FM)/Dallas and will start his new gig September 12th. Leaving WHTZ is **Paul “Cubby” Bryant**, who will now be working mornings with **Whoopi Goldberg** at sister WKTU and other syndicated stations. Kincaid had this to say: “This is dream come true for me. While it's tough to leave all the great people at KISS in Dallas, it is an honor to work at Z100. I can't wait to get started! And, I gotta thank **Davy Crockett, Rob Morris, Rich Davis, Jason Kidd, Patrick Davis, Mike Klein, Jake Redman** (who is very talented and still needs a gig!) and of course **Sharon** and **Tom** at Z100! This is a dream come true!!!!”

Many of the **Journal Broadcast Group's** radio stations, including WTMJ-AM/Milwaukee, KTTS-AM and KGSF-AM/Springfield, KFDI-AM and KFTI/Wichita, and KFAQ-AM/Tulsa, are committed to covering the 2006 general elections. They will be providing a minimum of five minutes of news coverage on weekdays in the 30 days before the election. This is part of the “2006 Red, White, and Blue Initiative” that includes the TV news operations. The segments

will focus on federal, state, and local elections and will air in high listener time periods. The stations will also run PSAs to get out the vote, and will feature profiles and interviews of candidates, as well as some viewer/listener questions and debates.

Changes. Kannon with a K leaves the afternoon drive at **Beasley** Top 40 Rhythmic WRDW/Philadelphia to cover the much-desired afternoon drive slot at **Clear Channel** Top 40 WKSC/Chicago. Also joining WKSC for middays is **Nina Chantele**, coming from **Entravision** Urban/Hispanic KZZA/Dallas, where she covered the Music Coordinator/afternoons position...Long-time radio programmer **John Roman** becomes PD and 3-7 pm afternoon host at **Cumulus Talk** WWCK-AM/FLINT, MI. Also at WWCK-AM, former WFBE/FLINT morning show member **Rusty Thomas** joins as Roman's afternoon producer...Effective 9/5, **Nick Ring** becomes the Internet Sales/Non-Traditional Solutions specialist for the cluster at **Clear Channel/Madison**...**Patti Banner** joins **Brain Casey & The Wake-Up Bunch** at Oldies KOLA/Redlands, CA, exiting her previous job at **Nextmedia** AC WZSR/Crystal Lake, IL as the PM drive host.

Many changes are afoot at **Summit City Radio**. Alternative WXTW/Ft. Wayne will flip to Spanish on 8/31, as it has been sold. Until the sale closes, the new start-up group—ex-**Artistic Media Group**/Ft. Wayne GM **John Henry** and local hockey legend **George Kostopoulos**—will operate the station under the LMA agreement. 8/31 also ushers in more format changes: Adult Hits WXKE will switch to a simulcast of Adult Standards WGL-AM. WXTW PD/morning man **J. J. Fabini** moves to a WXKE as MD/middays. Fabini will also retain PD duties of Adults Standards WGL-AM. Bringing back the original call letters, frequency, and PD that defined the market's Heritage Rock stations from 1979-2002, Top 40/Mainstream WXKE will flip back to Rock as WXKE (ROCK 104). Appropriately, **Doc West**, who programmed ROCK 104 for 23 years, returns for PD/mornings, transferring from Classic Rock WCKZ. WCKZ will switch to a simulcast of ROCK 104. WXTW morning co-host/middays **Lauren McCrady** moves to AE for ROCK 104.

Tired of high gas prices? **Cricket Communications** is trying to help by offering their listeners a “Morning of Free Gas” on Thursday, 8/24. Joining with **Entercom AC KOSI**/Denver, the **Murphy & Jo** morning show is going to announce the secret location at 6 am. Savvy listeners will be able to start pumping free gas at 7:30 am.

The plug has been pulled on *Mancow in the Morning* at **Archway Rock** KKZR/Little Rock. They are playing more of “The Monsters of Rock” in the morning, and examining options for the future, according to OM **Charlie Kendall**.

Connoisseur Media had acquired KBBX from **Journal Broadcast Corporation** and **John Ginzkey** had been named GM of Connoisseur's Omaha cluster. Additionally, Connoisseur anticipates that a new FM station will be on the air by 2007, and they have already secured a construction permit.

Sports WFBZ/Trempeleau-La Crosse, WI and a K270AG translator in La Crescent, MN, until recently owned by **S&S Broadcasters**, have been sold to **Sparta-Tomah Broadcasting** for \$850,000, with an LMA before closing. **Sparta-Tomah** now owns several properties in the market, as it also owns Country WCOW and Talk WKLJ-AM.

For \$120,000 and a noncompete agreement, AC KANS/Emporia, KS has been sold to **Marty Hill's Kansas Radio** for \$120,000. The deal was closed by **Ed Lipson's C&C Consulting, Inc** on Thursday, 8/17. However, since September 1st, 2003, the buyer has been operating the station, acting under a time brokerage agreement.

Mike Claiborne is leaving **Big League Broadcasting** Sports KFSN-AM/St. Louis. He is just moving across town, though, to join **CH Holdings** Talk KTRS-AM as the pre- and post-game host for the Cardinals and Blues.

Paula McKay, AM show co-host over at **NextMedia** AC WXSJ/ Crystal Lake, IL, along with co-host **Gary Castaldo**, and the rest of the WXSJ team, managed to raise over \$100,000 towards the operating budget of a McHenry County domestic violence shelter. Turning Point, the shelter, was unable to open due to a lack of available funds, despite being built over 3 years ago. It will now be able to serve over hundreds of families, thanks to the effort of Paula and WXSJ.

Jeff Deminski and **Bill Doyle** are owed congrats on their seventh anniversary at **CBS Talk** WKRK/Detroit's afternoon drive. After several years in the same time slot at Talk WKXW/Trenton, the duo arrived in Detroit in 1999.

The show will focus on the process of songwriting, asking artists behind-the-scenes questions regarding some of their classic songs.

Hearty congratulations to another Conclave Legend (2005) **Keith Urban**, whose single "Once In A Lifetime," made history as the highest debuting single in the 62-year history of the Billboard Hot Country Song Chart. It debuted at No. 17, outperforming his two previous singles, which debuted at No. 18. Congratulations are also due the staff of Capitol/Nashville! "Once In A Lifetime," is the first single off Urban's forthcoming album release.

Congratulations are due to **Clear Channel** Top 40 KDWB/ Minneapolis APD/MD **Lucas Phelan**, who married bride **Stephanie** in an impromptu ceremony in Las Vegas last week. There is no truth to the rumor they were married by an "Elvis" who looked remarkably like Lucas' boss, **Rob Morris**.
