We'll be back in January with all the news we can report, steal, and/or make up. On behalf of the Main Street and Conclave staff headquartered here and embedded with our troops abroad, we wish you a very Merry/Happy Christmas/Hanukah/Kwanza/Solstice/Festivus. The Main Street/Conclave offices will be open through the holidays (albeit with staggered hours - REALLY staggered - we like to PARTY 'round here). Expect your next **TATTTLER** on or near January 5th, 2007. Yeah we might publish - and then again, we might not. Who d'ya think we are, the freaking New York Times??? Ho! Ho! Ho!

Air America Radio has a letter of intent from a potential buyer! **The New York Times** names former network CEO **Doug Kreeger** and former Chairman **Terence F. Kelly**. Neither Kreeger nor Kelly would tell the Times when the deal might be done ("any number of things can happen," Kreeger told the paper) and Kelly said another strategic media partner is involved, although he would not name that party. The article also details the network's troubled history, including **Product First President Stu Kran's** contention that the network "really put this together without broadcasters" and original investor **Sheldon Drobny's** claim that "what (the net did for \$45 million they could have done for \$10 million." Kelly, however, counters that the network "clearly had an impact on the 2006 election...I think with a relatively small amount of money, we have succeeded wildly," and touts "the absolute untapped potential for 24/7 online streaming that has never been absolutely monetized." He also notes that "I have come to understand very clearly that the radio component of this requires a radio professional."

Mancow back on the air in Chicago? WLS/Chicago will be the two-day home for **Erich "Mancow" Mueller** during middays, December 27th & 28th. As you know, Mueller has hosted his syndicated radio morning show from WKQX/Chicago for years and is a contributor to the *Fox & Friends* cable news program. Will the Mancow appearance turn out to be permanent in the new year? The answer for now is 'no', but stay tuned...

Just in: **Clear Channel** says it will keep liberal talk affiliate WXXP /Madison will keep the format on the air rather than switch to a planned sports format on January 1. Listeners had protested the proposed move in a rally last week.

Jay Clark, EVP of **Sirius Satellite Radio** and frequent **Conclave** faculty member is retiring from the company. Clark joined Sirius in April 2002 after a long programming career, including stints at WABC-AM/New York, KLSX and KBZT/LA, STKS/Orlando, WLLZ/Detroit, WRKO/Boston, and STIC/Hartford, as well as **Comedy World Radio Network** and **Sports Fan Radio Network**.

After two decades at WDVE/Pittsburgh, **Scott Paulsen** is crossing the street to work for CBS Radio's WRKZ! Paulsen's contract with **Clear Channel** ended in September, and his last broadcast there was Friday (12/15). However, with a non-compete clause in his contract, he won't be able to launch his **K-Rock** show until April.

Jason "Big J" Harris has wrapped up (literally!) his second annual "**Big J Show's Santa Clause For a Cause**" give drive on Tuesday. **The New Northwest Broadcasters** KRSQ/Billings morning man and his co-workers began wrapping roomfuls of gifts donated for needy families in the Billings area. "Last year we were able to help 4 or 5 families (but) I modified the way I did things this year and we were able to reach our lofty goal of 32 families!...32 families is an entire city block here in Billings- I counted! I really hoped we would come close but I didn't think we would actually reach our goal, between you and me." The show received 50 nomination letters proposing families in need, culling it down to 32.

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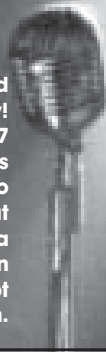

Guest opinion: From *Inside Radio* **Tom Taylor** – It was another important theme of last week's **Arbitron** Fly-in – and when **Edison's Larry Rosin** brought it up during a panel he wasn't (for once) talking about radio's audience. He was looking out from the stage and observing the average age of radio's consultants and researchers. Sure it takes years in the trenches to gain the experience necessary to become a top independent programming consultant group PD or researcher. But Rosin points to **McVay Media's** 20-something whiz **Daniel Anstandig** and observes that Larry himself might be the next youngest guy in the room after Daniel. And there were at least 75-80 souls in the auditorium). This comes back to what *INSIDE RADIO* told you in our Friday morning Fly-in issue – radio's not capturing the 12-17 and young adult generations. And perhaps one reason it's not (other than advertiser fiats) is

that it's not looking hard enough to include younger minds in the decision-making. There's been a generational change in America. Has radio kept up? (*As you know from reading last week's TATTLER, the Conclave is partnering with Edison Research to present the industry with "30 Under 30" reasons radio can meet the generational question Tom Taylor astutely asks above. When details of the 2007 Learning Conference are revealed in the first quarter of the new year, expect to see the industry's first focus on this important challenge.*)
