Congratulations to Conclave Board member, **Lester St. James**, as he takes the reins as OM of Three Eagles/Lincoln cluster! Lester will be overseeing programming for an eventual six stations, after **FCC** and **DOJ** diversification of the recent **Clear Channel** additions is completed. Before joining Three Eagles, Lester was programmer at KEZO/Omaha. He's been in the industry for over 25 years, with previous stints at Wichita; Carbondale, IL; Evansville, IN; and Sioux Falls, SD.

The battle is on between last year's Conclave keynoter, **Rev. Al Sharpton**, and rap artists using offensive lyrics in their music. Sharpton is taking cause to the boardrooms in New York this week, and says he

plans to buy stock in **Time Warner** and **Universal Music Group**, which own the rap labels **Def Jam** and **Roc-A-Fella**. He will use his **National Action Network** to make the purchases, and plans to attend board meetings to directly complain to the sources of misogynistic lyrics. He noted, "Some of the stockholders have no idea that they own stock in a parent company that own companies calling them 'bitches' and 'ho's.'" Sharpton will also head up a "decency march" next month, targeting **Sony**, **Time Warner**, and **Universal Music Group**.

**Don Imus** has legal representation, as reported by **Businessweek** magazine this week. He's hired powerhouse **Martin Garbus** to represent him, although his legal concerns are unknown, as Imus has declined to discuss why he was hired. There was a sentence on Garbus' personal blog this week about representing Imus "in a dispute with CBS," but that sentence has since been deleted. Garbus has represented such icons as **Lenny Bruce**, NYC mayor **Michael Bloomberg**, **Nancy Reagan**, and rap group **Public Enemy**. A spokeswoman for CBS would not comment on the matter, but Imus had recently signed a contract with CBS that would have paid him about \$10 million a year for the next five years. His dismissal has lead to press buzz about how it will affect the company. **MSNBC** has also declined to comment on the matter.

Executive Producer of "**Imus in the Morning**," **Bernard McGuirk** has been fired by **CBS Sports** WFAN-AM/New York. McGuirk was responsible for some of the comments made on the incendiary show that brought the shock jock down a few weeks ago. McGuirk joined the show in 1987 and provided character voices and comments for the show. **Rob Bartlett**, another character sidekick, told **Opie and Anthony** last week that he does not yet know whether he's been fired or not, but added, "It's [Imus' firing] like getting the death penalty for traffic violation."

The **MSNBC** morning TV slot left vacant by **Don Imus** is being filled by **Jones' Stephanie Miller**! She'll appear Monday through Wednesday of next week, replacing this week's host **Michael Smerconish** of WPHT-AM/Philadelphia. There were whispers that **ESPN's "Pardon the Interruption"** and WTWP-AM/FM/Washington host **Tony Kornheiser** would be next week's auditioner, but this has proved to be false.

The lawsuit involving **CBS Radio** and Talk KCAA-AM/San Bernardino-Riverside has reached a settlement. The station agrees to end its reruns of **Imus** shows, and CBS will drop its demand for \$150,000-per-episode damages. The settlement plan will go before **U.S. District Judge Virginia Phillips** next Monday.

**College Creek Media LLC**, owned by one **Chris Devine**, has decided to sell its construction permit for two new FM's in Paxton and Sutherland, NE to **Legacy Communications, LLC**, owned by **Jay Vavricek**. The price is set for \$475,000, and there is also a time brokerage agreement, which allows the buyer to build and manage the stations prior to closing.

Two more writers will be hired for the station's "**Morning Fix**" show, and a production manager will come in for Manno. He'll continue until May 7. Q101 has also made the announcement that the "stuff between song" is going to be the major focus for the on-air changes while preparing for Arbitron's Portable People Meter. RVP for Emmis **Marv Nyren** commented, "With more choices than eve, and

a new electronic measurement system coming soon, it has never been more important to deliver content customized for Chicago's young adult audience. These changes reflect Q101's commitment to combining great alternative music with comedy, news, and entertainment in all dayparts. No other market in the country compares to Chicago and its legendary radio personalities. Sherman and Tingle are the next generation of great talent and will bring an original entertainment experience to Chicago radio."
