Senators **Robert Menendez** (D-NJ) and **Ken Salazar** (D-CO) sent a letter to **FCC** Chairman **Kevin Martin** strongly suggesting a formal inquiry into **Arbitron's** Portable People Meter and the effects on minority radio stations. The letter read, as follows, "Minority themed radio stations are providers of important news and critical information about issues that are vital to the people in our communities. Stations that broadcast into minority communities provide a window into their languages, views, and values that might otherwise be ignored. When we talk about these outlets, we're not just talking about broadcasters, we're talking about advocates—advocates our communities depend on. Unfortunately, the PPM rollout is putting the viability of many minority radio broadcasters at risk." Arbitron continues to insist the FCC has no jurisdiction.

The **House Commerce Committee** released its report on the **FCC** and its ops under Chairman **Kevin Martin**. The report rips Martin for politicizing and micromanaging the Commission while undermining the regulatory process. The report, named "Deception and Distrust," said Martin committed "egregious abuses of power," but falls short of accusing Martin or the Commission of breaking the law or any rules. Further accusations point out that Martin manipulated reports to influence Congressional debate on "a la carte" cable channel sales and cable regulation, and that his "heavy-handed, opaque, and non-collegial management style has created distrust, suspicion and turmoil among the five current commissioners." Committee Chairman **John Dingell** (D-MI) and Oversight Subcommittee Chairman **Bart Stupak** (D-MI) released the report earlier this week.

"The R.O.I. for the traditional diary service has become invasive to these commitments. Market ratings should be a tool for better service to the advertising community, not a burden on our industry. Eastlan is a refreshing option with increased sampling and a more user-friendly

pricing model." "We're looking forward to providing service in Appleton-Oshkosh and Green Bay in 2009," said Eastlan President/CEO **Mike Gould**. "They are among the first markets we are aware of that are scheduled to have Eastlan, **Arbitron** and **Nielsen's** aided-recall sticker book measurement fielded concurrently." *Comment: Wow! All 3 ratings firm rating the same stations in the same market. THOSE results should be verrrry interesting, indeed! - TK*

Steve passed (12/8) of a sudden heart attack while on vacation. "We're all just plain shocked," said **Dial Global** Pres. **Kirk Stirland**. Young spent the last eight years as Dir./Rock And Pop Programming, and then as Sr. Programming Consultant at Dial Global (previously **Jones Radio Networks**), and programmed stations such as WAXQ/New York, KISW/Seattle among others, as well as serving as Operations Dir. at WNEW/New York. *Comment: If there was a gentler, kinder, more-giving person in the industry than Steve, we're not sure we've met them yet. Steve was the consummate professional and friend. It was a common site at the Learning Conference to see Steve holding court with students and newbie broadcasters, dispensing knowledge and advice. His knowledge of rock radio is unparalleled, which is why we tapped Steve every chance we could to act as a conference faculty member. We are richer for having known him, and the industry is poorer now because we've lost him. To say he will be missed would be a gross understatement. - TK*

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Congrats to **J. Pat Miller**, who's transferring from Omaha to Milwaukee as the new PD of **Journal's** recently flipped Adult Hits WLWK (94.5 The Lake), the former Hot AC WKTl. Miller will also do mornings on The Lake starting in January, and comes in from Hot AC sister KSRZ (Star 104.5)/Omaha, where he's been PD since June 2006. Prior to Omaha, he spent time in Lincoln, NE as OM/PD of **Triad's** four-station cluster there. Also at The Lake, **Mathew Blades** returns. He had been the morning person at WKTl but went off-air when the station flipped. He'll do early afternoons, starting later this month.

The **Tribune Co.** has filed for bankruptcy protection (Chapter 11). The **Chicago Cubs** and **Wrigley Field** weren't included in the filing. Tribune went private last December in a buyout by real estate mogul **Sam Zell**, who paid more than \$8 billion.

Chicago Public Radio Noncomm Talk WBEZ/Chicago sliced 11 FT staffers. Many senior staff members took pay cuts. The cuts were blamed on a "poor financial conditions" including a drop in individual donations and smaller than expected growth in corporate underwriting resulting in a \$1.5 million budget shortfall, according to the station's website.

Clear Channel Sports WCWA-AM/Toledo Morning man **Troy Neff** was stabbed Wednesday in a road rage conflict. The police arrested Jeffrey Hardeman of Knoxville, TN. Neff was taken to the hospital for emergency surgery but is expected to make a full recovery. Neff told police that he and his assailant got out of their vehicles and exchanged words before fighting, at which point the radio host was stabbed in the upper abdomen.

Former **Center for Community Development** Noncomm Urban AC KMOJ/Minneapolis host **Quincy Smith** was killed Monday morning after being tasered by Minneapolis Police. Smith, known as "Q the Blacksmith" allegedly threatened his girlfriend with a rifle, which is why the Police were there.

Citadel Talk KWQW/Des Moines midday host **J. Michael McKoy** exits. Station officials are calling it a budget cut, but McKoy filed a grievance over his firing, saying, "I was told on Friday that my job would probably be eliminated because of budget cuts and at that time I had offered to do the show for...the minimum wage and the company had turned that down."

The fight over 'High School Sports' has landed **Riverfront Broadcasting**, **James River Broadcasting** and the **Pierre School Board** in court. Riverfront is challenging a five-year exclusive deal inked by the school board and **James River** to put the games on Country KGFX-AM. Riverfront owner **Carolyn Becker** said, "There are a couple of things under South Dakota law that show that a school district does not have the right to do that type of contract."

CBS News WBBM-AM/Chicago has seen a massive increase in web hits since the arrest of Illinois Gov. **Rod Blagojevich**. Page views jumped 253%, daily unique users soared 204%, search referral traffic rose 169%,

the top streaming hour was up 396%, and average hourly streaming listeners over the entire day showed a 270% increase.

Since the shutdown of **Anheuser-Busch's Bud Productions** TV and radio, the **St. Louis Blues** will move radio production duties "in-house." The new Belgian owner of A-B has shut down the production house that handled **Cardinals** telecasts and Blues radio.

Cumulus Rock KDVV/Topeka stopped morning dude **Joe "Joey Baggz" Little** from crossing the street to join rival **JMJ Broadcasting** Classic Country KTPK-FM before his noncompete expires. Cumulus fired Little on August 27th and Tuesday he announced he was joining KTPK as a PT production assistant. Actually, he's eligible in February.

Tribune Talk WGN-AM/Chicago and **Tukaiz Imaging-Print-Interactive** join forces for a promotional campaign to sell personalized 2009 calendars. Listeners can incorporate their names directly into the calendars' 12 different monthly images of famed Chicago landmarks. WGN's former Creative Director **Todd Manley** recently announced that he was exiting **CH Holdings** Talk-Sports KTRS-AM/St. Louis to join **Tukaiz** as Manager of New Business and Consumer Markets.

Cumulus Country WWWW/Ann Arbor joins **Key Bank**, **US Marine Corps** and **Washtenaw County Toys for Tots**. WWWW's "Crusade for Kids" starts Monday at the local mall where the station will broadcast live for the week accepting toys and/or money.

Dispatch Broadcast Group/RadioHio Sports WBNS-AM and AC WBNS-FM/Columbus will host their annual radiothon for 'Adventures for Wish Kids' on Saturday. The company raised over \$200,000 at the 2007 Radiothon and well over a million dollars over the past 12 years.

Three Eagles Rock KIBZ/Lincoln, NE raised \$19,894 this last weekend during their 17th annual 'Kampout for Kids.' The 30-hour event benefits the Lincoln Auction Program to help needy families during the holidays.

North American Broadcasting Adult Standards WMNI-AM/Columbus inks minor league baseball team, the **Columbus Clippers** to a five-year deal.

Midwest Family Top 40 WIZM/La Crosse, WI launched "Pat and AJ TV" on their website <http://www.z933.com/>.

Hubbard Broadcasting Talk KSTP-AM/Minneapolis parts ways with fixture **Tommy Mischke**. Mischke was asked to leave the building after his show Friday, less than 12-hours after the station hosted a release party for his new CD. Tommy had been with the station since 1992.

Veteran radio personality **Mike Tanner** joins **Sovereign City** as afternoon host (2-6p CT) for the company's Oasis AC format. Tanner's resume includes 23 years of satellite AC format radio, plus stints at WLS-AM and WYEN/Chicago and KMPC-AM and KMGG/Los Angeles.

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Play MPE VP/Operations Dean Ernst is no longer with the company, effective immediately. Details on his exit are not available.

Lincoln Financial Top 40/Rhythmic KQKS/Denver promotes **APD/MD John E. Kage** to PD. Kage was handling programming duties since former KQKS PD and now KYLD/San Francisco PD **Cat Collins** left in October. Kage has been APD/MD at KQKS since 1999.

Antioch University noncommercial **WYSO/Yellow Springs-Dayton, OH** names **Neenah Ellis** as GM.
