WTF? FCC OVERRULED! The **FCC's** "fleeting expletives" indecency rules were tossed out by the **Second Circuit Court of Appeals** earlier this week. The ruling replied to the Commission's determination that the expletives as heard on **The Billboard Music Awards** on **Fox** were "actionably" indecent, saying the FCC was "unconstitutionally vague, creating a chilling effect that goes far beyond the fleeting expletives at issue here." The Court also indicated that the entire Commission indecency policy was invalid. The decision written by **Judge Rosemary Pooler** stated, "We agree with the networks that the indecency policy is impermissibly vague. It results in a standard that even the FCC cannot articulate or apply consistently." Next stop for the case will likely be the Supreme Court (on appeal by the Commission.)
