

Tomorrow (8.28) in Washington DC, two 2006 Conclave keynoters battle ideologies. **Premiere Radio Networks** and **Fox News Channel's Glenn Beck** is holding a "Restoring Honor" rally on the steps of the Lincoln Memorial, upsetting community activists and civil rights groups who plan to march and counter-demonstrate. The rally is scheduled on the 47th anniversary of **Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s** "I Have a Dream" speech. The other Conclave keynoter? **Rev. Al Sharpton. National Urban League President Marc Morial** says the timing of Beck's rally "is insulting" and "an effort to embarrass and poke a finger in the eye of the civil rights community because Glenn Beck and his public utterances don't necessarily demonstrate a consistency with the vision of Dr. King...Our rally is not an 'us against them.' We want no confrontation with Beck. But, we want a confrontation with the ideas he espouses. His ideas seem to be ideas of intolerance." Beck says that the rescheduling of his rally for the anniversary of King's historic speech was unintentional but has called the coincidence "divine providence." *COMMENT: If we'd have only known the future four years ago, think of the debate we could have had at the 35th Learning Conference last month!! - TK*

Clear Channel is publicly distancing itself from WHO-AM/ Des Moines morning host **Jan Mickelson** for his on-air comments on homosexuality and AIDS that "confused strong opinion with medical fact and contained factual errors regarding HIV/AIDS, how it's spread and current efforts to

inform the public about this disease." However, Mickelson's views were apparently not offensive enough to warrant being fired or suspended. This story begins when Mickelson pressed **Iowa Republican Party Chairman Matt Strawn** for criticizing a GOP legislative candidate for posting anti-gay statements on his Facebook page, by saying "HIV/AIDS does not discriminate." Mickelson said the disease does discriminate against those who engage in "stupid behavior," and since homosexuality is a "sexual disorder" that violates natural law, it "isn't rocket science" to conclude AIDS discriminates against homosexuals. "Homosexuality is intrinsically promiscuous because it violates the design of our bodies," he continued. "There is no safe way to do that." Before Mickelson's show Thursday, CC management read a statement on the air saying that Mickelson "confused, strong opinion with medical fact and contained factual errors regarding HIV/AIDS, how it's spread and current efforts to inform the public about this disease...Furthermore, "Mr. Mickelson's comments do not reflect the opinions of Clear Channel, nor do they reflect the ongoing support Clear Channel provides to public service campaigns, such as Greater than AIDS, that works to convey the message that AIDS does not discriminate. We regret any confusion about HIV/AIDS that may have resulted from Mr. Mickelson's remarks." LGBT-rights organization **One Iowa** Exec. Dir. **Carolyn Jenison** released a statement saying, "Jan Mickelson's comments on HIV/AIDS are reprehensible. Stigma and discrimination surrounding the discussion of this epidemic are barriers to prevention and treatment of HIV/AIDS. Clear Channel did the appropriate thing in responding to and correcting this misinformation." "We thank Clear Channel for addressing this issue in an on air clarification, to ensure that WHO-AM's millions of listeners will have the facts about HIV/AIDS, and dismiss the highly offensive, anti-gay and misinformed statements made by Jan Mickelson last week," **GLAAD** Dir./National News **Cindi Creager** said. "We'll continue to pay close attention to future broadcasts, and Mickelson's defamation will not go unchallenged."

New PD **Emily Stevens** crosses the street from **Clear Channel** Top 40 KKXL. Working with OM **Jarrold Thomas** will be new Assistant OM **Joshua Fleming**, the former VP/Programming for **Royce Broadcasting's** KRCK/Palm Springs, KFRH/Las Vegas and KREV/San Francisco.

Clear Channel Pres./CEO **John Hogan** released an internal memo this week citing the departure of EVP/Online Music-Radio **Evan Harrison** at the end of the year. Harrison had been instrumental in shaping CC's digital strategy. Hogan praised Harrison for developing and launching CC's custom content for its station websites and mobile applications.

Dial Global and **Cox Radio** NT WSB-AM-WBTS-FM/Atlanta host **Neal Boortz** will host the **2010 National Radio Hall of Fame** induction broadcast November 6th at 9p (CT) live from Chicago. Boortz, the 2007 Conclave keynoter who was also inducted into the Hall in 2009, will be joined by fellow Hall of Famer **Jim Bohannon**.

Journal/Wichita, including: Country KFDI, Classic Country KFTI and Oldies KLIO raised \$116,675 for the **Kansas Honor Flights** scheduled for this fall. The Honor Flights fly WWII vets to Washington DC free of charge so they can visit the WWII memorial. Local businesses and listeners donated money during a nine-week campaign that included daily on-air interviews with organizers of **Central Prairie Honor Flights** in Kansas, as well as many vets.

Mid-West Family Pres./GM Kevan Kavanaugh announces significant promotions and a staff addition to their four stations in Springfield, IL. **Susan Groves**, who was OM and PD for the three FM's is now the OM for all four, but will also remain PD for WQLK and an on-air talent at WLCE. She will also continue to be instrumental in major station and cluster promotions. **Jim Leach**, who was the News Director and PD (plus morning show host and Promo Director) of WMAY is now the News Director for all four stations and will continue to PD WMAY. **Josie O'Donnell**, who was APD of Alice (plus Alice mornings & promotions) will now be PD. **Chris Murphy** joins the company as Assistant OM for all four stations, PD of WNNS, APD of WMAY and afternoons on WNNS plus news anchoring on WMAY. Murphy had worked for Mid-West from '95 to '06 and was PD of WMAY for most of that time.
