*The Tattler* reported last week on **2005 Conclave Keynoter Al Franken’s** alleged knowledge of shady financing at **Air America**. Another week, another name added to right-wing blogger **Michelle Malkin’s** ever-lengthening list of wrong doers in the **Air America/ Gloria Wise Boys and Girls Club/ Evan Cohen/Al Franken** debacle: **Sinohe Terrero**, VP of Finance for Air America. While holding that title alone is hardly an indictment, Terrero’s past involvement with the financials at Gloria Wise seems cause for concern from Malkin and collaborator **Brian Maloney**, who point out that Terrero happened to be handling money for the Boys and Girls club from 2000-2002—years that coincide with Evan Cohen’s ill-fated rein as head of AAR. The network has denied that its present ownership has any legal responsibility to pay back the loan despite its appearance on a list of liabilities in a “settlement agreement” signed by Cohen, former partner **Rex Sorenson**, the current owners, and Franken in late 2004, but says it has put the disputed amount in escrow held by its own attorney to be paid back at the conclusion of a city and state investigation. Reports of Terrero’s resignation remain unconfirmed.

It looks like **Bonneville International** will continue to play whatever they want, after all. Chicago District Court Judge **Morton Denlow** ruled in favor of Bonneville in a suit brought against them by **JACK-FM** owner/US licensor **Sparknet Communications** which alleged that the former’s use of such slogans as “70’s, 80’s...Whatever We Want” and “70’s, 80’s...Whatever WE Feel Like” infringed upon Sparknet’s copyrighted “Playing What We Want”. Darrow felt that the overlap of a few words simply did not constitute a trademark breach. An appeal by Sparksnet is already in the works along with analogous cases against various **Clear Channel** outlets in California, South Carolina and Iowa.

**Bustos Media Networks** takes on programming duties for **NextMedia/Milwaukee’s** formerly Country WEXT as the station makes the flip to Spanish today (9/16). Cluster VP/GM **Kira LaFond** will launch the new format by playing 10,000 consecutive songs.

Steve "Homer" True's departure from Clear Channel Talk WISN/Milwaukee will also mark the removal of his longstanding sports/talk presence on the station. With the host's move to competitors Good Karma Sports WAUK/Milwaukee-Sports WTLX/Madison, WISN PD Jerry Bott couldn't see his way clear to maintaining True's 9pm timeslot. It will instead be filled with Sporting News Radio until permanent replacement programming can be found.

Clear Channel Country KZSN/Wichita APD/MD/midday talent Pat Moyer will be adding News Director to his duties. The four-station Wichita cluster has announced plans to introduce a live, local News Department, with Moyer at the helm. Also joining the team in an anchor capacity will be Dan O'Neal, reporting news and traffic.

Hubbard Broadcasting welcomes back familiar face Steve Konrad as Director of Programming for KSTP, WFMP and WIXK/Minneapolis. Konrad is returning to the Twin Cities, where he was the PD at KSTP from 1991-98, from a stint in Ohio working for Clear Channel.

From 1980 to 1989, Mason and Michaels were the morning voices at the venerable KOIL/Omaha. Now there back together on the air at Talk KKAR where they'll be doing...mornings! Former Conclave Board member Terry Mason and co-host Clay Michaels will be replacing Kent Pavelka's morning news block.

Jeff Smulyan, CEO for Emmis, along with Radio One's Alfred C. Liggins III and Former FCC Chairman Richard Wiley have joined forces as investors interested in bidding on ownership of the Washington Nationals. One of eight groups in the running for the purchase, the big wigs will have to wait until the end of the month for a decision from Major League Baseball, awaiting the approval on a pending lease on a new stadium from the District of Columbia.

Jay Philpott, fresh off his creation of the incredible Ain't Misbehavin', Just Conclavin' Conclave 30 year retrospective, will now join the crew at Saga Rock WHQG/Milwaukee. 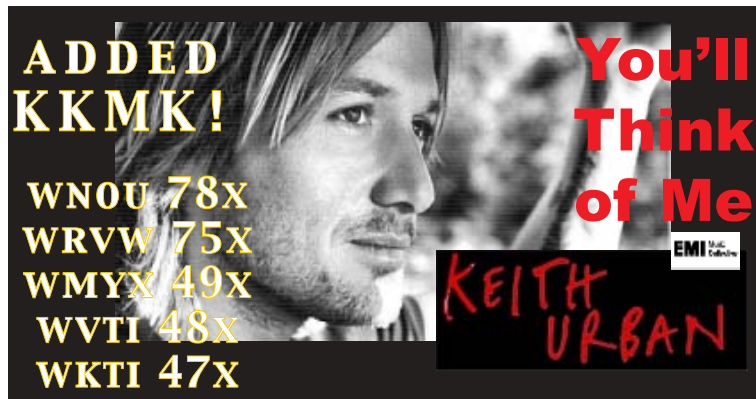

Kriegler comes to the job after spending time as GM for **Prairie Communications** News Talk WBYS-Classic Hits WCDD/Canton, IL.

In the wake of the exit last week of PD/morning man **Train**, **Cumulus** Top/40 Rhythmic WTWR/Toledo has made the move to Mainstream. Mornings will now be manned by **Johnny D & the Morning Crew** who to them from crosstown **Clear Channel** Top 40/Mainstream WVKs. Joining Johnny & co. will be **Crystal Harris** while WVKs mornings go to night guy **Kramer**.

When the **Chicago White Sox** move their game broadcasts to **Infinity** Sports WSCR(the Score)/Chicago, morning man **Mike North** hopes he'll be providing the color commentary.
